

SUPPLY LISTS 2009-2010

Kindergarten

- **Small backpack** – it will only hold their lunch box and folder
- **Folders** – usually 1 or 2 will last for the school year
- **1 pack of pencils** – very plain as they are shared – may be purchased at the school store
- **Glue sticks** – at least 4 to get started – may be purchased at the school store
- **1 Box of crayons – 8 pack only** – larger packs of crayons will not fit in the pencil pouch we supply for each student. Each student will need a new pack of 8 crayons after Christmas.
- **1 box of washable markers with normal colors** – black, blue, green, purple, orange, yellow, red, brown
- **1 pack of construction paper** – packs of solid colors are great and can be purchased at The Learning Station (downtown Newark) or The Teacher's Book Bag (People's Plaza) – most used colors are: white, red, pink, green, blue, purple, orange – white is used more than any other color
- **1 pack of white copy paper**
- **2 boxes of tissues**

Donations of scrap paper for drawing are gladly accepted.

GRADE 1

Here is a list of school supplies that I would like for you to have when school begins:

- 2 Boxes of Tissues (the family size – we are looking for quantity not quality)
- 1 Container of Clorox wipes (or any other brand name)
- 1 pair of Scissors
- 5 Glue Sticks
- 8 Pack of Markers
- 16 Pack of Crayons
- 10 Pencils (please put your child's name on them)
- 4 Composition Notebooks (please put their name on them)
- Math Flashcards for Addition and Subtraction (to be kept at home)
- Clear Contact Paper to cover their workbooks (to be kept at home)
- Paper
 - **Boys:** Package of Construction Paper
 - **Girls:** Package of Computer Paper
- 4 Tennis Balls - Please cut a 2-3 inch slit into the tennis balls so that they can easily be put on the chairs and desks
- 1 Folder (this can have any design on it)
- Pencil Case (Please purchase a zipper pencil case only.)

I would like for you to bring in the following colored folders:

- 1 Red
- 1 Blue
- 1 Green
- 1 Yellow
- 1 Orange

(Please make sure these folders have 2 pockets in them and do not have a design on the front. Laminated covers work the best.)

GRADE 2

- 2 bottom pocket folders
- 3 marble sewn tablets
- 3 sharpened pencils
- 1 pink eraser
- 2 packages of **wide ruled** loose-leaf paper (not college ruled)
- 3 glue sticks
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 small box of colored pencils
- 1 box of 24 crayons
- 1 **soft zippered** pencil case – large enough to hold pencils, crayons, colored pencils, glue stick, and eraser
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 1 container of antibacterial wipes
- 1 roll of clear contact paper for covering books
- 1 large book sock to cover the reading textbook
- 4 tennis balls with a 2-inch slit in each (approx.)

GRADE 3

Each incoming 3rd grade student is responsible for bringing in the following supplies on the first day of school, Monday, August 31, 2009:

- 1 box (minimum 24 count) #2 pencils, sharpened (no mechanical pencils, please)
- Pink eraser
- 24 count crayons or colored pencils
- 2 glue sticks
- 1 pair school scissors
- 1 soft pencil case (no hard boxes, please)
- 4 “2 pocket” folders
- 4 marble composition books, 100 pages each
- 1 - 12” ruler with both English and metric measurement
- 2 – 8 oz. (or larger) hand sanitizer
- 3 large boxes of tissues
- 1 pkg. disinfecting wipes (girls only)
- 1 pkg. all purpose copy paper (boys only)
- 5 extra-large book socks to cover textbooks
- Clear contact paper (please keep at home to cover workbooks during the first week of school)
- 4 tennis balls with a 2-inch slit in each (approx.)

Additionally, each student should have 1 or 2 packages of wide-rule loose-leaf paper, **at home**, to be used for homework assignments.

GRADE 4:

- Red erasable pens
- 8 tennis balls (Please have an adult use an Exacto knife to cut a 3" slit into each ball to be used on your desk and chair to protect our floors.)
- 2 packages of wide ruled loose leaf paper (not college rule)
- 4x6 index cards (on-going supply)
- Case, with compartments, in which to keep cards
- Clear contact paper (Please keep at home to cover practice books.)
- 1 eight-pocket folder
- 1 folder for daily take-home communication/homework (two pockets)
- One yellow highlighter
- One package colored pencils or crayons
- Scissors
- Regular #2 pencils (no mechanical pencils, please)
- Erasable blue or black pens (no click pens)
- 1 pink eraser (optional)
- Glue sticks
- 12-inch ruler with inch and metric markings
- One five star spiral notebook (with inside folders)
- 2 marble composition notebooks
- Zippered pencil case (no boxes)
- 2 large boxes of tissues
- 1 large container of antibacterial wipes
- 4 tennis balls with a 2-inch slit in each (approx.)
- Large book socks

GRADE 5

- 12-inch ruler with inch & metric markings
 - Pack of colored pencils (12-24 pencils)
 - Regular #2 pencils - NO MECHANICAL PENCILS
 - One large pink eraser
 - Pack of 8 markers
 - A yellow highlighter
 - Blue or black erasable pens, and a red erasable pen
 - Scissors
 - Glue sticks (no liquid glue)
 - Compass
 - 4 x 6 index cards (on-going supply at home for Vocab. and Current Events; bring one pack with you to school)(any light color is okay – please don't get the 3 x 5 size – past experience has shown me that they are too small for our purposes!)
 - Zippered pencil case (NO boxes)
 - 4 folders with bottom pockets (NO 3-ringed binders)
 - 1 bound, marble composition notebook for Reading. (Students new to ICS should bring 5 bound composition books.) I have your tablets from 4th grade in the 5th grade classroom. We will use these first and replace when/if needed. You will be given a homework planner on the first day of school.
 - Graph paper – centimeter grid
 - Clear contact paper to cover practice books. You will also need Book Sox and/or another type of book cover to cover 5 large textbooks. (Keep these supplies at home – books will be sent home for covering during the first week of school.) Textbooks must be covered at all times. Thanks!
 - Pocket dictionary
 - 1 large container of antibacterial wipes for desk cleaning (Clorox, Lysol, etc. – no Baby Wipes please – let's try to keep the germs down!)
 - 2 large boxes of tissues
 - 4 tennis balls with a 3-inch slit cut into each (for desk legs – our chairs will be updated with permanent scuff guards, so we only need them for the desks). **Please make sure that you have your parents/guardians cut the tennis balls before you bring them to school.** It is much easier for each of you to cut 4 tennis balls than for me to cut 100! An Exacto knife works well for this. Any uncut tennis balls will be sent back home with you as your parents'/guardians' first homework assignment of the new year! We really appreciate your assistance with keeping our new floors shiny and beautiful!
- Wide-ruled loose-leaf paper (supply for class and at-home)

No white-out, flair or roller-ball pens, no click pens or gel pens or college-ruled paper.
